Cliff Rieders presented to the 8th Annual Medical Malpractice Seminar Update on behalf of the Pennsylvania Association for Justice in Philadelphia on November 19, 2013. Mr. Rieders was a featured speaker on the update of case law. Medical liability claims are highly dependent upon decisions from the Pennsylvania appellate courts. Attorney Rieders, a Nationally Board Certified Trial Advocate, has written and lectured widely in the medical liability field. The textbook, Pennsylvania Medical Malpractice Law and Forms is a longtime publication of the Pennsylvania Association for Justice and is authored by Rieders.

Mr. Rieders' presentation covered all of the relevant decisional law from the Commonwealth in the last three years. Pennsylvania is a leader in the development of law in connection with the interface of medicine and the legal system. Rieders was involved in the drafting and negotiations concerning the "Mcare" Act, House Bill 1802 signed by Governor Mark Schweiker on March 20, 2002.

Attorney Cliff Rieders has a statewide practice as a litigator in the medical liability field, including pharmaceuticals. Rieders is admitted to federal and state courts, including the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, New York State, and the District of Columbia. Rieders is also admitted to the United States Supreme Court.

Attorney Rieders is a longtime participant in the medical malpractice colloquium held in Philadelphia as well as a teacher in a number of other statewide programs which are intended to educate, inform and train other trial lawyers in the practice of medical and hospital, as well as pharmaceutical, liability issues.

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
