Cliff Rieders Teaches at the Premiere Annual Medical Malpractice Seminar



Cliff Rieders teaches once again at the Premiere Annual Medical Malpractice Seminar held at the Thomas R. Kline Institute of Trial Advocacy in Philadelphia Thursday, October 24, 2019.

Attorney Rieders, a partner in the law firm of Rieders, Travis, Humphrey, Waters & Dohrmann, gave the Annual Update: Adapting to the New Case Decisions. In particular, Mr. Rieders discussed the controversial subjects addressed by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court concerning the fact that only doctors can give Informed Consent, and a more recent decision that the Risks and Complications of surgery may reflect on whether a physician is guilty of negligence. Rieders' book on medical malpractice is regarded as the seminal work on medical malpractice and is widely used by the courts and practitioners alike.

Cliff Rieders is a Past President of the Pennsylvania Association of Justice, formerly the Pennsylvania Trial Lawyers Association. He was President of the Federal Bar Association, Central Pennsylvania Region. He is a Phi Beta Kappa Cum Laude graduate of New York University and of the Georgetown University Law Center. Rieders clerked for the Honorable Malcolm Muir. He is a life member of the American Law Institute, which drafts proposed laws for the fifty states. Rieders is a nationally Board-Certified trial lawyer and is a prolific author, teacher and trial lawyer.
